Criteria for Small Grants

Due to the large number of requests for support Churchill Foundation receives; we ask those considering approaching us to consider the notes below regarding eligibility and the submission process:

- Churchill Foundation assigns an amount of funds at the beginning of each financial year to go towards the small grants programme
- Small grants are donations between £50-£2,000
- Charities must only apply if they fall into the 3 key areas and objective of Churchill Foundation, which enables charities to transform people's lives through investment in:
 1. The relief of sickness, disease and human suffering
 2. The promotion of health amongst the elderly
 3. The support and wellbeing of the young
- The charity must be registered in the UK or Wales and independently audited.
- The charity must be independent of state, political party and religion.
- Small grant applicant must be put forward via one of the following ways: a trustee, member of staff, business partner or owners and emailed to enquiries@churchillfoundation.co.uk
